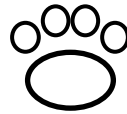

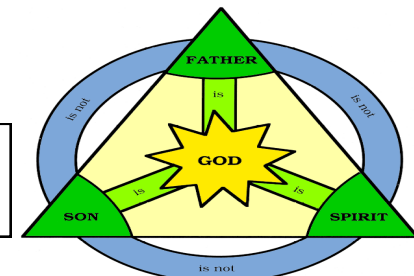

Summer Mass Program

Due to changes in the visa system it has become much more difficult to get priests to come to the UK to cover during the summer months for holidays.

Bishop Joseph has asked that as deaneries we look at reducing the number of masses over July and August to allow the priests we have to be able to cover each others summer holidays. As a deanery we have been looking at this and after looking at the radical idea of halving numbers of masses across East Kilbride (to one evening and one morning mass in each parish) we have decided that we do not this year need to be so radical but we do still need some reduction.

Thus each parish is during July and August cut one mass either their vigil mass or Sunday evening mass so that across EK there will be 2 Vigils and 2 Sunday evening masses.

We are therefore during July & August putting off our 1800 Sat Vigil mass
Revised evening mass times across East Kilbride will be:

Sat Vigil Masses :

1700 Our Lady of Lourdes

1800 St Brides

Sun Evening mass:

1600 St Vincents

1715 St Leonards

Sunday Morning masses will not change in any of the parishes and we will return to the normal mass times in September.
